LIBERTY ARTS OFFERS INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR NORTH CAROLINA SCULPTURE STUDENTS

Durham, NC - Liberty Arts, a nonprofit bronze casting facility located in historic Durham, NC is currently taking applications for a summer internship for outstanding undergraduate and graduate students. The program is open to both U.S. and non-U.S. citizens. However, the latter must be enrolled at a U.S. University and have proper work and residency documentation. Internships are available beginning in July and ending in late August for an 8-week assignment. To meet individual needs, some flexibility in the beginning and ending dates is possible. Students are allowed access to the casting facility and equipment and given up to \$500 worth of supplies and consumables in lieu of a stipend. Housing assistance is not provided.

Each intern can expect to work with Sculptor and Casting Facility Manager, Michael Waller, on a variety of ongoing projects, assist in community classes and bronze pours, and work on their own projects. Liberty Arts is particularly interested in candidates with a sculpture background and a desire to understand and learn the metal casting process. The ability to work without close supervision in a careful and conscientious manner is essential.

Applicants should send letter of reference (on letterhead), sculpture-related resume with email address and 10 digital images (in jpeg format on CD) of work produced within the last two years to: Liberty Arts, Inc., ATT: Summer Internship Program, 538 Foster Street, Durham, NC 27701. Deadline for applicants is May 29, 2006. Applicants will be notified by June 17, 2006.
